Physical Requirements

Must be able to perform under periodically disagreeable working conditions, including working outside, at times in inclement weather, and exposure to water, dust, dirt, grease, paint fumes, chemicals, and equipment noise and vibration. And must be able to be on your feet for prolonged periods of time.

Must be able to do frequent lifting/carrying of objects up to 25 pounds, and less frequency up to 50 pounds and occasionally up to 100 pounds with assistance.

Incumbents in this position are also required to bend, kneel, crouch, reach, climb, walk, and run. Examples include the ability to shovel or dig in the ground, kneel to lay carpet, bend, twist, and stretch while painting, climb up and down an extension ladder, climb up and down stairs, walk on the roof of a building or uneven surfaces, and to run to shut off a water line when ruptured.
